We have up to 18 children in each class, with a teacher and an assistant. Our teacher is Mrs. Terri Camilleri, and the assistant is Mrs. Kerry Rau.

Our 3's do not leave the building - we have field trips come to them. We have a dental hygienist, the fire department, the librarian, a llama or Critter Caravan will come to visit, Mystic Aquarium comes and brings some sea creatures. We also have a professional photographer come in to do pictures.

Parents are asked to send their child to school with a healthy snack each day. Please note that we are a nut-free preschool. Our classes do celebrate holidays. We have parents sign up to bring a special snack on these days and parents can also sign up to come into the class to help.

All 3's must be potty-trained prior to attending preschool. We are not licensed for diapers, therefore, pull-ups are not allowed as they are considered a diaper).

All children must be up-to-date with immunizations and must have a flu immunization prior to December 31st.
