The musical source has as many versions as do the various musical interpretations of the melody. (Scholars have concluded that it was not a "bar" song as some have speculated. The combination of text, melody and phrasing are indeed unique, inspiring and a living sand dynamic part of our worship and praise.)

We need everyone's help to make this a success. This will be a great way to let Cromwell and beyond see what a great community of faith we have here at Bethany.








What you need:

- An adult to help
- Newspaper
- Acrylic paints :
- Paper plate
- Paintbrush
- Small terra cotta pot and plate
- Cup of water
- Permanent black marker
- Potting soil
- Small "indoors" plant or packet of seeds

What you do:

- 1. Cover your work area with newspaper and squeeze paint onto the paper plate.
- 2. Paint designs on the pot and plate, cleaning your brush in the water when changing colors. Let dry.
- 3. With the black marker, write "Growing in God's Grace" along the top ridge of the pot.
- 4. Pour in a small amount of soil. Place your plant in the pot and surround it with more soil. (If planting seeds, follow packet instructions.)
- 5. Water your plant. Check it daily and keep the soil moist.
- 6. Enjoy watching your plant grow!
